HOW TO MAKE A BIRD-SHAPED BIRD-BOX

Pupils from Hessle High School worked with artist Louis Dorton to create these birdboxes. Here's how you can make one for your garden!


FIRST, GET A PLANK! about 15cm wide and at least 168cm long

MAKE A HOLE. Make it 32mm for a house sparrow, which is a great bird to encourage in your garden!



THEN MARK THESE

MEASUREMENTS ON IT:



CUT THE PIECES

PUT ALL THE PIECES TOGETHER!

Mark the places for 2 screws on each edge.

 Drill pilot holes to stop the wood splitting.

 Use galvanised screws that wont rust.


Use a piece of rubber or leather to make a hinge for the roof so you can clean it out.



PRIME AND PAINT YOUR BOX



DESIGN AND CUT



Put the two 350mm back pieces side by side and draw a simple bird shape. Make sure it can fit a rectangle 150×250mm inside it.
